On my Facebook page, people I really care about often strongly disagree offering up harsh words to each other. I want to think that the body of Christ behaves differently, but it doesn't. Our life together, the unity of the church, and God's mission in the world are dependent on how we are able or not able to work out our differences.

The Apostle Paul wrote to the church in Corinth because they were struggling with issues that threatened to tear the church apart. First Corinthians redirects our attentions toward our true identity found only in Jesus Christ. I invite you to consider participating in the study, ***First Corinthians: Living Love When We Disagree***. Together we will learn some practical truths we can implement in our relationships in order to live love even when we disagree without compromising our own beliefs.
